DIALOG, along with the rest of the Acciona-Ghella JV team, is designing and building the new Broadway Subway Project in Vancouver. This is a 5.7-kilometre extension of the existing Millennium Line, traveling from VCC-Clark Station in East Vancouver to the Broadway and Arbutus intersection on the west side of the city.

DIALOG provides integrated design services for the Great Northern Way-Emily Carr and Arbutus underground stations and at-grade exits/street interfaces. Great Northern Way is the first station being built and sets important precedents for the others to follow; Arbutus is the last station to be built. The completion date is now projected for 2027.
