

2024 DIALOG Scholarship in Honour of Michael Evamy

The Board of Trustees is pleased to announce the twenty fifth year of the Scholarship in Honour of Michael Evamy. This scholarship, awarded annually, is available to a Canadian student attending a Canadian School of Architecture in the year prior to his or her final year of study of their professional degree program.

DIALOG* established the Michael Evamy Scholarship Foundation to honour the memory of Michael Evamy, a partner instrumental in building our integrated practice from 1966 to 1993. The award provides financial assistance to the selected student to undertake a specific research project based on a field of study of interest to him or her. The intent of the study is to enrich and advance the candidate's personal and professional experience and knowledge on a topic relevant to the practice of Architecture.

The value of the award in 2023 is \$5000. A secondary amount up to \$3000 is available for project related expenses, including travel expenses, during the course of the investigation.

The application deadline for the award is April 1st, 2024.

The successful candidate will be notified and the award publicly announced in April 2024.

A. Eligibility and Conditions

- This award is open to all Canadian students enrolled in a Canadian School of Architecture in the year prior to their final year of study in a professional architecture degree program.
- Confirmation of willingness to work within the available funds.
- Confirmation of willingness to present their results as described in "C".
- The award money must be used within one calendar year following notification of the award.

B. Selection Criteria

Selection will be based on the following criteria:

- The candidate's expressed interest in the scholarship and his/her chosen field of study.
- The specific nature of the investigation relative to his/her chosen field of study.
- Demonstrated academic achievement and leadership ability.



C. Presentation

The successful candidate will be asked to prepare a talk for public presentation and publication. DIALOG will organize the talk together with a reception. Travel expenses for the Talks will be funded separately from the Scholarship.

D. How to Apply

The application is to be **received** by DIALOG no later than **11:59PM MST April 1, 2024**.

Project description and methodology to be a maximum of 1000 words plus images (if applicable).

Please provide the following information:

1. Cover Page

The cover page should clearly indicate the applicant's name, title of the proposed project and date of submission.

2. Table of Contents

3. Project Description

Clearly and concisely identify the nature and objectives of the proposed project and how it relates to the specified field of study. Describe the scope of the project and define what the project intends to accomplish.

4. Project Methodology

Outline how you propose to conduct your study (e.g. travel, research) including the general approach to the collection and analysis of information (e.g. photography, sketching, literature review, interviews, etc.).

5. Project Schedule

Outline the time frame and location(s) of the study including time allotted for specific project tasks. If travel is involved, provide a proposed itinerary.

6. Project Budget

Outline anticipated costs related to undertaking the proposed project. Include a breakdown of essential expenses such as travel (airfare, food, accommodation) telephone, postage, photography, photocopying, supplies, etc.

7. Portfolio

Provide one example of previous project work demonstrating design and presentation capabilities.



8. Information on the Applicant

Please provide the following information:

- i. Name
- ii. Email address
- iii. Mailing address
- iv. Telephone number
- v. School of Architecture
- vi. Academic record
- vii. Awards, honours, grants received

9. References

Each applicant is required to obtain three letters of support demonstrating the applicant's leadership skills and ability to complete the proposed project. Reference letters are to be sent directly to the Scholarship Manager.

All material submitted will become the property of DIALOG and will not be returned to the applicant.

E. Submission

Your application may be submitted either by mail or electronically.

If sent by mail, please provide three (3) sets of information as listed in Section D.
